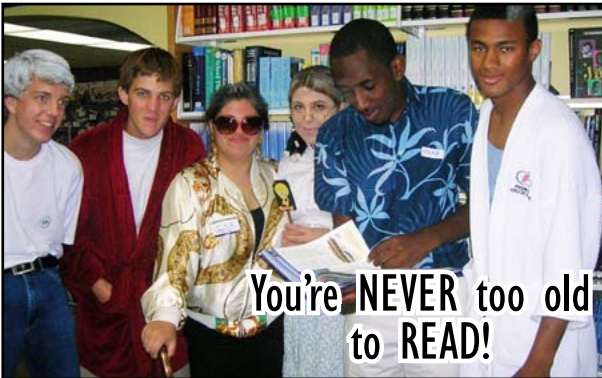

The Regional meet is Sat., November 10th at Westminster Academy.

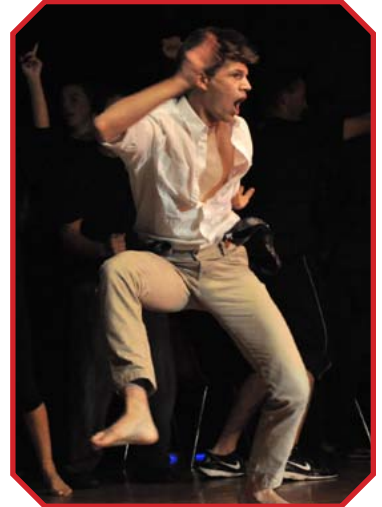

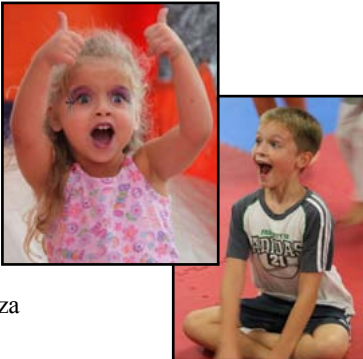
CSCA Karate Program
