Payment is due the first day of each week.

Registration fee is \$50 per family through May 24.

Beginning, May 25, the registration is \$75 per family.

This one-time fee is not refundable.

Returning Campers:

Bring in a new first time camper and get the big trip fees waved for the summer.

Rates include admission fees for most field trips, afternoon snacks and two camp T-shirts.

On the week of June 13-17, the camp participates in Vacation Bible School in the morning and field trips in the afternoon.

Lunch will be offered daily for \$4.00 with over 10 entrees to choose from.

Each Thursday parents will receive an informational email and activity schedule for the following week. This schedule will help campers know when to bring their bathing suits and towels. Please mark all belongings with the campers name and place them in a bag or backpack.

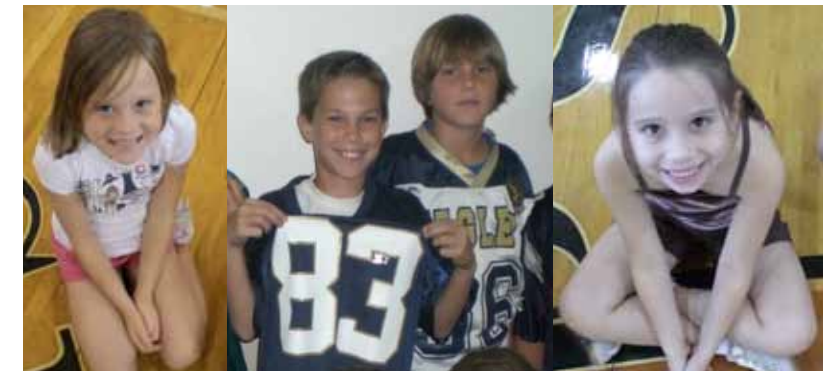
