## Wow! It is time to honor our Summer Birthdays for our CSCA Birthday Book Club 2011-2012!

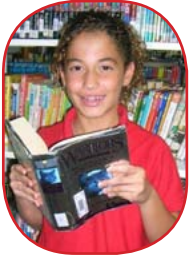
