CSCA's Champions for Christ Awards Program

The Champions for Christ Awards Program is the official celebration of gifts and talents at CSCA in three primary areas (academics, leadership, and service) embodied in our school's mission statement. At the end of each quarter, an assembly will be called and the Headmaster will present to our champion students gold medals. The awards program is open to all students in Fifth Grade through High School. There are three main award categories:

Academics

Straight A's in all subjects

Leadership

Student must be nominated by a coach, fine arts, or special activity teacher as someone who is exemplary of good leadership qualities. *A student leader is one who places the welfare of others above self or sacrificially encourages others to do their best.* The Principal reserves the right to accept or reject nominations. A very brief sentence of leadership actions must be written by the respective staff member to the Principal.

Volunteer Service

Fifth grade students: 15 hours per quarter

Secondary students: 25 hours per quarter

Student must freely help a needy person or group for no personal gain. A form available in the school office must be signed by the recipient of service and turned in by the student to the principal before the deadline.

The Grand Finale

After medals have been given at three award assemblies there will be a grand finale celebration. Elementary and Middle School Students who have earned any combination of **five gold medals** will be publicly honored and then taken by special limousine to Boomers amusement park for a day of celebration paid for by the school. High school students who qualify will have a celebration lunch at the beach.
