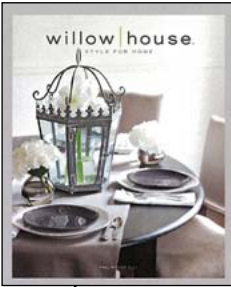
Brownie Troop #10750 collected left over Halloween candy to send to deployed U.S. service members through “**OPERATION GRATITUDE.**”

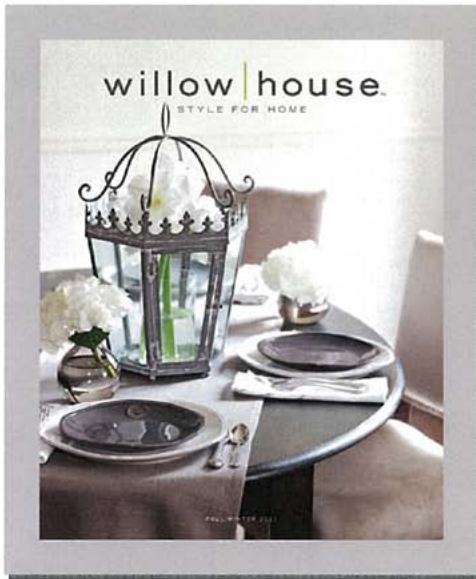

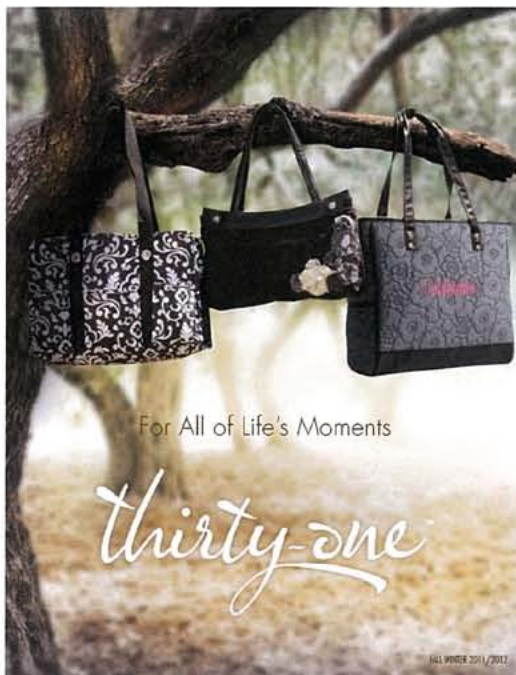
