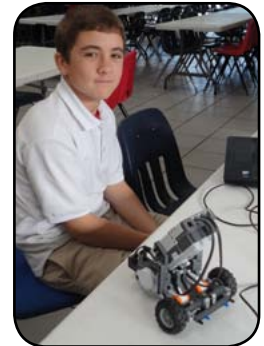

# ROBOTICS CLASS



This year the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade have a new addition to their list of classes. The robotics class is a wheel class that each 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade student will take for 1<sup>st</sup> quarter. Mr. Thompson uses the Lego robotics system and the Robot I Engineering program. This was designed for Lego by the Carnegie Mellon Institute. The class has a set of new laptop computers that are used to write programs. The programs control the robots in much the same way that the moon and mars rovers were controlled. As the students engage in the fun of watching their robot accomplish task, they are learning about technology and lifelong skills for their future.

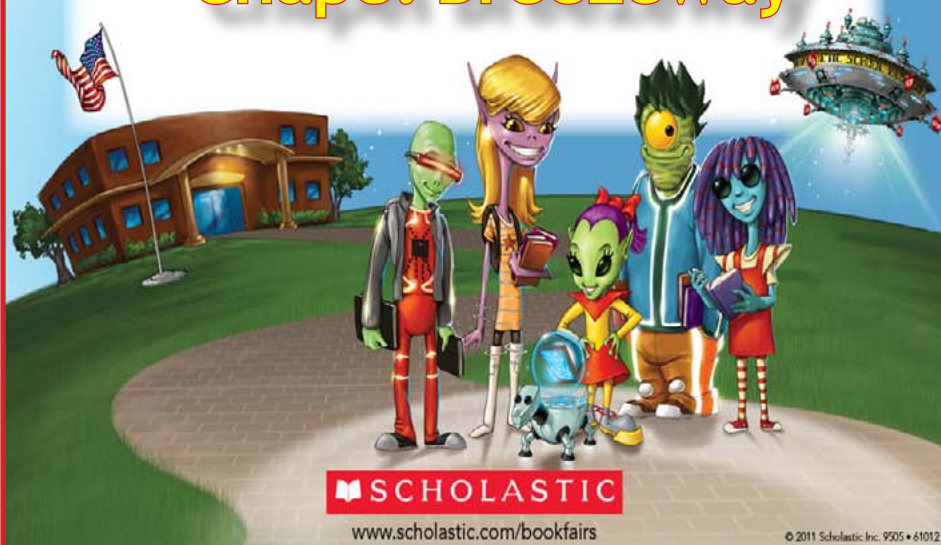

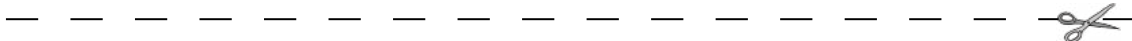
